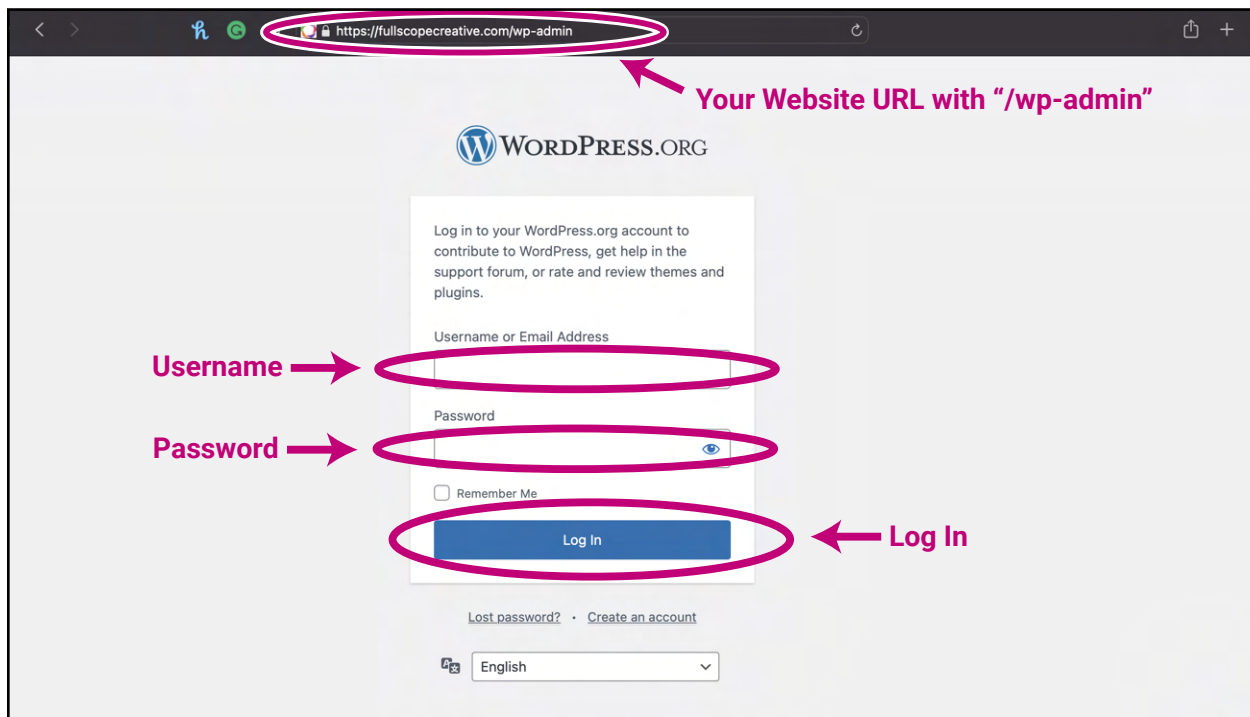



SIGNING IN

The first step to any process of editing your website will be to sign in to your website:

1. First go search your website's URL and add **"/wp-admin"** at the end: **"example.com/wp-admin"**
2. This will take you to your sign in page where you will enter your username and password and then hit **"Log In"**



2. You should arrive at the Wordpress Dashboard where you can make needed edits to your website.
